Having a hand washing facility in the school brings comfort



Somrong Chey Primary school has 159 students (75 girls) located in Somrong Village, Boeng Bath Kandoul Commune, Bakan District, Pursat Province. Student sanitation is a concern for teachers because students played on the ground, cleaned trash, and went to restroom. Poor sanitation has seriously affected student's educational performance. Responding to this, principal Mr. Sun Phy requested to and got handwashing facility support FLD on December 31, 2020. After constructing the facility, students, with the supervision from teachers, used and cleaned it regularly before and after eating and after having restroom. Therefore, hygiene and sanitation at school have been improving remarkably. "After receiving this handwashing facility, all students in my school practice hand washing regularly when their hands are dirty and have poor hygiene. They also cleaned facility, latrine and trash at school. Epidemic and poor sanitation diseases won't affect students again", said
